To apply for an award

Who's eligible?

All K-12 education professionals, whether or not they are clients of Voya Financial®, are eligible. Specifically, these individuals must be:

- Employed by an accredited K-12 public or private school located in the United States
- Full-time educators, teachers, principals, paraprofessionals, or classified staff with effective projects that improve student learning

Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, age, gender, disability, or national origin. Previous recipients of Voya Unsung Heroes awards are not eligible to apply for another award.

Awards

All awards must be used to further the projects within the school or school system. Indirect costs or administrative fees should not be paid or withheld from the grant award. Each of the 50 finalists will receive an award of \$2,000. Award checks are made payable jointly to the recipient and to his or her school. Of the 50 finalists, three will be selected for additional financial awards. First place will receive \$25,000; second place will receive \$10,000; and the third place winner will receive \$5,000. By fall, all applicants will be notified whether or not they have been selected to receive an award.

Project description

Thorough description of your project, clearly stating what you and your students will do. Describe its objectives and how your project is new or different.

Benefits to students

How many students does or will the project directly benefit? How will your project improve student learning and impact other students and teachers, parents, and your community? How will you evaluate the effectiveness of your project?

Use of funds

What funds/money, materials, or other resources you currently use or will use to operate your project. How will you use the \$2,000 award? How will you use additional money up to \$25,000?
